

Guided group work is appropriate for pupils of all abilities and should be offered to all over time. It can be focused to support the needs of the following groups of pupils:

- low-attaining pupils – for example, those with limited comprehension who may need support reading the information available to them;
- pupils who have had limited experience in developing their techniques with specific ICT tools – for example, those pupils who need support with manipulating a database;
- very able pupils – for example, those who would benefit from time with the teacher for acceleration and enrichment;
- targeted groups – for example, pupils learning English as an additional language, who may be in need of intervention with English syntax, or other groups in need of particular support.
