

Teachers' level decisions – assessment 2

My presentation

At this stage the example illustrates aspects of work at level 4. The pupil has effectively combined and refined his information from a narrow range of sources. The photographs were either taken with a digital camera or were scanned and clip art was added. The work has been amended to take account of the audience. The pupil has demonstrated a good level of technical capability in these areas.

Some aspects of the presentation show were less effective. For example, the timed transitions gave the audience insufficient time to read the text or for him to present it. The task was to produce a presentation about himself, but he included more about his family than himself.

Disco model

This example illustrates aspects of work at level 5. During the process the pupil explored relationships and interpreted the outcomes, questioning when changes were not appropriate. The final report reflects an understanding of the effect of changing the variables, including recommending a lower cost solution for higher profit. It is fit for its purpose and is clearly structured.

Public information system

The example illustrates aspects of work at level 6. The pupil has used information from different sources and has created an ICT structure to display the information. Emphasis is placed on fitness for purpose for an audience seeking weather information. The system shows a degree of integration of different ICT facilities and, by doing this linking, the pupil has made the system more efficient and more appropriate for the audience.
