

Teacher statements

Use this sheet with Teacher resource 9.

Do the data for the 33 168 pupils in the survey support these statements?

Slide 1

- More than 11 000 children travel to school by bus, about one-third of the total. (Yes)
- More children walk to school than use transport. (No)
- A lower proportion live in families with two or more cars than no car or one car. (No)
- Of those who walk to school, the highest proportion live in families with one car. (Yes)

Slide 2

- 88% of children in the survey have access to a computer at home. (Yes)
- More than 80% of children in the survey had breakfast on the day they filled in the questionnaire. (Yes)
- More than twice as many children had a mobile phone at the time of the second survey. (No)
- The second survey was conducted during the year 2000. (No)

Slide 3

- These data were collected by a university. (It depends)
- These data come from a reliable source. (It depends)

Slide 4

- These data come from a reliable source. (Yes)
- We can trust these data to be accurate. (Yes)
