In Citizenship at Key Stage 3 there is the opportunity to explore the impact of ICT e.g. the Internet, E-mail, and E-commerce and pupils may exchange views using Email. At Key Stages 3 and 4 ICT is used to extend reference sources through the use of CD-ROM and the Internet.

Other useful software includes a word processor to describe events and present work; desktop publishing software to produce newspapers of specific events, empathising with particular views; multimedia or web authoring software to make a presentation based on research; E-mail to enable pupils to communicate.
